

A FLOODLIGHT improvement project at Glenavon Football Club has been completed. The club marked the official switch on of the new floodlights at Mourneview Park on Tuesday night at its Carling Premiership match against Newry City FC.

Funding to complete this project was provided to the club by the Irish Football Association through the FIFA Goal funding programme.

The Club Licensing and Facilities Department of the Irish FA has been working for the past eighteen months in the delivery of the Floodlighting Improvement Project and Glenavon FC was successful in securing funding through the third phase of this programme. Previous phases of this programme have allowed five similar projects to be completed.

Glenavon FC Chairman Adrian Teer commented “We would like to thank the Irish Football Association for assisting the club in completing this project through the FIFA Goal Programme. Glenavon FC is currently undertaking a phased facility improvement programme at Mourneview Park and the installation of this new floodlighting system is an important step in this process.”
